2012 Inspection Agreement

All applications and necessary related materials must be submitted by February 29, 2012.

The Cooperstown Farmers' Market provides a central location for local producers to sell their products. The purpose of the market is to support and encourage locally grown produce and locally made crafts. To this end, 100% of the goods sold at the market must be grown or produced by the vendor within a 50-Mile radius of the market. (for exceptions refer to rule 26.) To help ensure that this rule is enforced the following guidelines have been developed.

The Cooperstown Farmers' Market reserves the right to inspect the farm, kitchen or production facilities of the grower/producer. The inspection will be conducted with at least 24-hours notice unless otherwise permitted by the grower/producer. The inspection will be made with a farm/production facilities representative present unless otherwise permitted by the grower/producer. Refusal to permit a farm or facilities inspection can result in suspension from the market.

Inspection criteria will be based on the vendor's market application. The purpose is to establish that the crops listed on the application are grown at the farm, and that crops are grown in corresponding amounts to what is sold at market. For baking and other processed goods, the purpose is to establish the necessary capabilities exist and support the product volume sold at the market.

Inspections will be carried out by the Market Manager. These inspections will be scheduled on a three year rotation for existing vendors, in year one for new vendors, and for investigating suspected violations.

In the event that a grower/producer is found to be in violation by the inspectors and refuses to provide access to their farm/kitchen/production facilities, they will be afforded a hearing before the Market Governing Committee, at which time the grower/producer can present evidence to support a defense. After the hearing the Market Governing Committee will render a decision. Disciplinary actions include, but are not limited to, temporary or permanent suspension from the market, and/or fines.
